Membership Rules and Guidelines

All members MUST fill out the Membership Application and Release form.

Membership dues must be paid in full. You will qualify for high point awards and accumulate points by joining by the end of any show but show points will NOT be retroactive to previous shows.

If volunteer hours are complete during a show, benefits will be in effect for the next show and the remainder of the show season.

Family members only are welcome to track volunteer hours for current members.

Volunteer hours must be tracked by using the HCHC Volunteer Hours tracking sheet. Hours will accumulate September 1 to September 1. Tracking sheet MUST be approved at PRIOR board meeting to be eligible to use Gold or Silver membership benefits at show.

Family memberships must all be living in same household. Each adult in household must sign releases and all youth members must have a Legal Guardian sign the release(s).

Membership perk guidelines will be tracked for the following year.
